

SYLLABUS: ACCT 6392 – INTERNSHIP

Catalog Description: A supervised field and academic experience. May be repeated once for credit for distinctly different learning experiences.

Prerequisite(s):

12 credit hours of ACCT and completed internship application form with permission of academic advisor, area coordinator, and experiential learning program coordinator.

Course Objectives:

To allow students to earn college credit for employment in a learning environment.

Current Textbook: None

Evaluation Process: Student performance will be measured through a report from the student detailing the experience and a report of the intern's performance from the employment supervisor. Other types of evaluation may be employed at the discretion of the faculty advisor or program coordinator.

Required Course Content: Individualized to student and employer.

Optional Course Content: Optional content may be agreed to between the employment supervisor and the program coordinator and/or faculty advisor.
